- III. Approval of Agenda- Approved
- IV. Approval of Minutes – Approved
- V. Treasurers Report – We have \$8,954.70 total. The Bowling Tournament Scholarship profit is at \$1,313.19.
- VI. President’s Report – Reported by Eric Guerra
  - a. Scholarship Committee – Bill went to Hiram Johnson to pick up three applications for the scholarship committee. He will read them and pass them on. The committee has about 2 weeks to review and make a decision. We as a group decided that we will give \$1000, \$750 and a \$500 dollar scholarships.
  - b. Redistricting Subcommittee – Reported by Madelyn~ 5 individuals on the committee. Tom R, Don P, Madelyn K, Bill M, and Kathy W. We discussed Tom’s great idea of all districts moving north and possibly collaborating on a map as a group that would make district 6 pull everyone east of highway 99 and north to Folsom Blvd. all the way south east to the city line. This would give us a great deal of diversity. It also would mean having one council member involved with the 65<sup>th</sup> street RAC, the Oak Park RAC and the Stockton Blvd partnership. Madelyn invited everyone to log in and do a map with their ideas. The next meeting will be May 10<sup>th</sup> at 6:00 pm at TCC. Please attend if you are interested.
  - c. Beautification Committee – Julie Mier from the city came to speak to TPNA about the Adopt a Park program. Typically the requirement is 4 cleanups (3 hours at a time) per year. No age limit to volunteer. We would need an ambassador to communicate with park staff. Julie can post opportunities to the city website. Also the

information goes to two big volunteer agencies in Sacramento. Would like to coordinate several cleanups close to each other in the neighborhood so that groups can share tools if necessary. The next clean up will be May 21<sup>st</sup> 9:00 – 11:30 am

- d. Community Meeting will be May 4<sup>th</sup> at Tahoe Elementary auditorium starting at 6:30 pm. Jay S. from district 5 will also be there to answer questions.
  - e. Pancake Breakfast will be May 14<sup>th</sup> at Tahoe Elementary
  - f. June 11<sup>th</sup> is the Health and Safety Fair at Tahoe Park from 10 - 2.
- VII. Unfinished Business –
- a. Redding Avenue outlet behind Target has not been finished due to having a problem with RT and the contractor. RT had to get the contractor trained but then reneged on payment of part of the deal. The project should be finished by the end of May.
- VIII. New Business –
- a. Red Card at Target. This program allows money's to be designated to the schools. Laurie Jones has been trying to get Hiram Johnson to be on the list of schools. Tahoe Elementary is listed.
  - b. Isaac looking into having a TPNA flag to go up on the flagpole. This project will probably take less than \$200.
  - c. Library Reopening Book Sale will be 5/23 and 5/24 from 2:00 – 6:00 pm
